WHAT IS A HYBRID CLASS?

Hybrid courses are delivered in an alternative format which features a 50% classroom and a 50% online format. The alternative format offers the benefit of face-to-face instruction while providing the convenience and flexibility of online instruction. Online instruction uses various methods such as document files, video, audio, discussion boards, chat rooms or any combination of these.

WHAT IS THE ADVANTAGE OF TAKING A HYBRID CLASS?

- Students interested in eliminating a weekly commitment to a standard classroom course will enjoy the flexibility available with hybrid courses.
- Cost concerned students will certainly appreciate the opportunity to travel less.
- Individuals who have considered taking an online course, but were concerned about the lack of a classroom instructor and/or interaction with classmates will benefit from the availability of standard classroom time combined with online course delivery.
