**APPLE NUT CAKE**



1 C softened margarine	2 C of sugar
3 eggs	2 C of flour
2 t cinnamon	2 t baking soda
4 C of diced unpeeled apples	1 C chopped walnuts

Topping for Cake

1 T margarine	1/2 C sugar
1 T flour	1/2 C water
1/4 t cinnamon.	1 t vanilla

Cream together margarine and sugar then add eggs, flour, cinnamon and soda. Mix together then add apples and walnuts. Bake at 325° in a greased and floured 13x9 cake pan for 1 hour

In a small sauce pan mix all topping ingredients except vanilla and boil until the mixture becomes stiff, about 5 minutes, remove from heat then add vanilla and pour over the cake while it is hot.

**CHEESY POTATO SOUP**



2 lb pkg hash browns	1 onion - diced
3 carrots - shredded or diced	4 ribs of celery - chopped
1 can chicken broth	1 lb pkg Velveeta cheese - cubed

Combine the vegetables and add broth and enough water to cover. Cook until vegetables are tender. Add cheese and heat until melted.

This is a very flexible recipe. If you don't want to use broth just use about six chicken bouillon cubes and enough water to cover the vegetables. Put into a crock pot and let simmer.

**SWEET POTATO CASSEROLE**



3-4 C mashed, cooked sweet potato	1 C sugar
2 eggs	1/2 C milk
1/4 C butter	1 T vanilla
1/2 t salt	

Mix together and put into a 13x9 inch baking dish

Topping:

1/4 C butter	1 C brown sugar
1/2 C flour	1 C chopped pecans

Mix until crumbly & spread over top of potatoes.

Optional: Garnish top with additional half pecan pieces.

Bake at 350° for 30 min.

Note: You can use the canned sweet potatoes [2 cans - 40 oz. ea. to equal 3-4 cups of mashed potatoes]. Casserole can be cooked in crock pot on High 2 1/2 hrs or Low 4-5 hrs.
