

There are many financial aid opportunities available for Hispanic students. Here are some sources to check out.

Federal Financial Aid:

Federal grants, loans, and work opportunities are available for citizens and registered aliens. Students may complete an application at: www.fafsa.ed.gov.

State of Kansas:

The **Kansas Ethnic Minority Scholarship** is available for African American, American Indian or Alaskan Native; Asian or Pacific Islander; or Hispanic students. Applications are available from Barton's Financial Aid Office. Email your request for an application to FinancialAid@bartonccc.edu.

Barton County Community College:

- La Oportunidad Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to students who are not eligible for a Pell grant and first priority is given to students of Hispanic descent. Applications are mailed to enrolled students who meet the criteria.
- Academic Scholarship – This scholarship is awarded to students based upon their high school GPA, ACT, or GED score whichever will result in the highest scholarship amount.
- Boost Scholarship – This scholarship is for high school students who are on free or reduced lunches.
- Incentive Scholarship – This is a need-based scholarship for students who are not receiving any other type of aid. Scholarship applications are available at: <http://www.bartonccc.edu/financialaid/scholarships/default.htm>.
