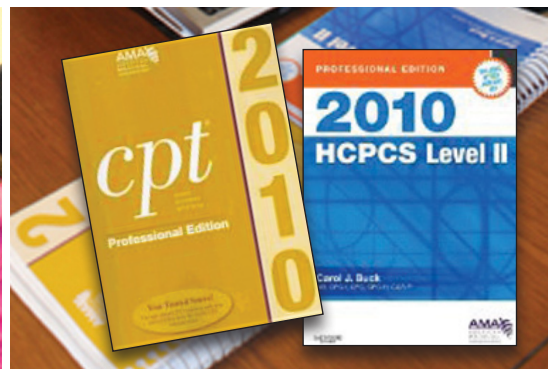

- Translate the information into numeric codes, using a universally recognized coding system.
- Insure correct code selection for compliance with federal regulation and insurance requirements.

What Barton Offers:

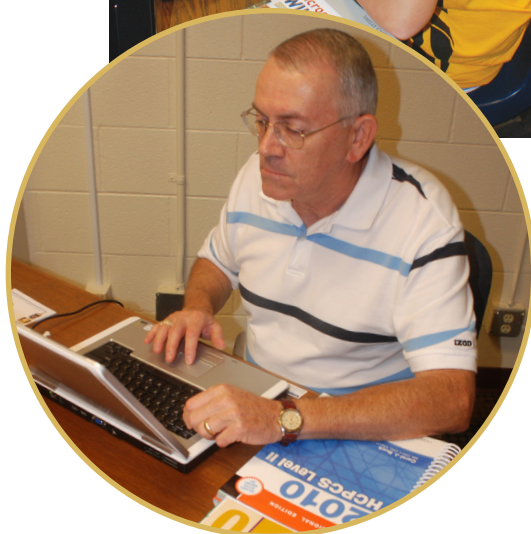
- Certificate (32 credit hours)
